PARKING:

Parking in the pits will be strictly for Team Rigs only. This means any crew members, family, fans, etc that are driving personal vehicles will need to park in the parking area behind the facility (please refer to parking diagram). NO PERSONAL vehicles will be allowed in the pits for this event. If your personal vehicle is pulling your race car – that vehicle will be allowed, but no others. Only one golf cart or 4 wheeler will be allowed in the pits per race team. ***If you will be arriving any other time than Friday November 26 – 27th, please text Joe Gentry your team name, Driver name, and arrival day and time so that a 417crew member can meet you to let you into the facility and assign your parking slab number. EVENT SCHEDULE:

The updated event schedule has been posted on face book and the website, along with being a portion of your welcome packet. Friday November 26th we will be hosting a Welcome & Thank you pit party, beginning at 8pm. We will have a live band. Food and beverages will also be available – for purchase. All are welcome to attend.

DRIVER REGISTRATION:

Pit entry is located directly ahead of you once you pull into the facility parking lot, in the white trailer at pit row entrance. **All Drivers** will be required to provide a completed Driver Info Form and W9 at check in. This includes Drivers that have a current 2021 packet on file with 417SSE. We understand this will take an extra 5 minutes of your time, but need to ensure the accuracy of who is receiving payout at the end of the evening. You will be issued a transponder after turning in your driver packet, paying for bands, and purchasing your tires and fuel. If you have your own personal transponder – please let our team know that, and check to be sure it is compatible with our scoring system. Please note – if you elect to make your purchases with a debit or credit card, a 3% CAP fee will be applied to entire transaction.

WRISTBANDS:

2-day passes will be available starting the week of November 22nd. If you purchase passes prior to Friday, November 26, you will need to exchange your ticket for your wristbands on Friday November 26th prior to proceeding through the gate. Please ensure your wristband is secure and remains on designated wrist the entire event. Any individual caught without wristband will be escorted off property and will not be allowed to re-enter- this includes children, spouses, crew members, etc

SLAB ASSIGNMENT: Slab assignments will be assigned upon arrival. Please be sure you are on your assigned slab. Please do not encroach on your fellow drivers pit slab. If you do not park where you are assigned and within that slab area only- you will be required to move, even if you are “already set up”

TIRE & FUEL PROCEDURES:

You are required to purchase 4 tires and 10 gallons of fuel. Please retain your receipt for the duration in the event any questions arise. If you elected to pre-pay for tires – you will receive a receipt upon registration that includes your selection position. Tire selection positions will be announced over the PA – please pay attention. You will be given 10 mins to check in at tire corral. If you do not show – we will move on to the next team. 4 teams consisting of 2 members will be allowed into the tire corral at a time. Once pre-pay teams are finished selecting their tires, all other teams will be allowed to start tire selection – but will be on a 1st come 1st serve basis. All race tires will be impounded. Once a tire has been mounted or removed from tire barn – no exchanges or refunds will be made – NO EXCEPTIONS. The only exception regarding exchanges would be for a manufacturer defect approved by Track owner only. Tires and fuel close promptly at 7pm. All purchases and selection will need to be made no later than 6:30pm.

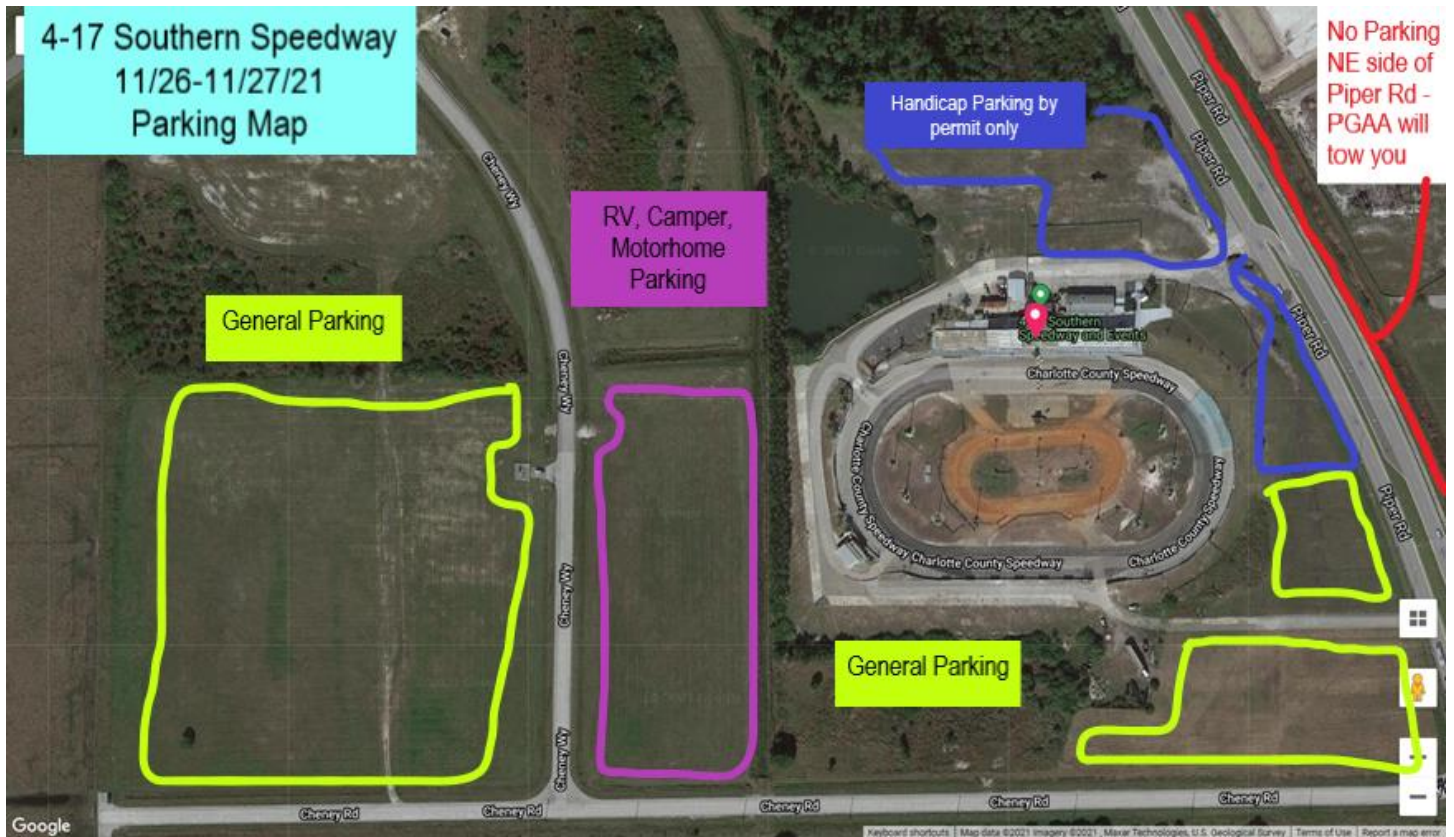
